The food packs were distributed during the Humanitarian Response Relief Operation in Northern Cebu last January 30, 2014. The recipient barangay was **Sitio Lunas, Barangay Cadaruhan of Borbon, Cebu.**

Each food pack was enclosed with a message which would hopefully encourage the victims – **“Do not give up HOPE....this too shall pass...”** and consisted of the following:

- 3 kg rice
- 5 canned goods (meat loaf, mechado, sausage, corned beef and sardines)
- 3 pcs instant noodles
- 5 sachets of pampainit (coffee, milo, energen etc)
- food pouch from GCH Food Products

A loaf of bread was also given to each student of the Amancio Sepulveda Elementary School. Meat Magic pouches and bottles of water were also distributed in addition to the 200 food packs.
